C. Johnson:

- Presented a picture of the
proposed playground at Donatoni
Park.
- Reported the quotes for the
projects at Donatoni Park.

Old Business:

S. Connington stated that Friend-
ship Field is getting dried out and
asked about irrigation. Mayor
Snyder reported that we are get-
ting a portable irrigation system.
S. Patamia said she will touch
base with J. Rossi and see what

the field looks like at the end of August
before a decision can be made
whether the field can be used in the
fall.

K. Snyder reported that she asked
Borough Clerk, S. Seifert to speak with
the town's insurance company. There
may be an extra insurance charge for
high school clinics to be added to the
town's insurance. (Using Our name as
one of their sponsors) C. Johnson
stated that they would not be added,
but should provide us with a certificate
of insurance. The issue needs to be
clarified. Discussion followed.

K. Snyder reported that she had a fol-
low-up with Town Engineer, M. Spil-
lane regarding football season at Do-
natoni and the asphalt at Centennial
Park. She asked him to push the pro-
jects along.

K. Snyder reported that she recom-
mends pulling the dog toilets at Park
Lake.

K. Snyder reported that she
received a request for the installation
of a fence at Friendship Field to keep
kids from going into residents' yards. J
Rossi will take care of this.

T. Mulligan said he is working on fall
baseball. He is trying to put two teams
together. Nothing is settled yet.
